The Mission of the Parent Partnership Organization (PPO) at Bergen County Technical High School, Paramus, is to support the education of our students. We celebrate leadership, community service and academic excellence.

Your student will benefit directly from your involvement in their school experience. We encourage you to join the PPO. **The annual dues are \$15 per family.** (There will be a \$25 fee for returned checks). These dues will be used to support school activities, present guest speakers and other events to promote your child's education.

The PPO also awards a scholarship to an eligible graduating senior.
