Measures of Academic Progress (MAP)-

MAP is a computer-based adaptive assessment that tests where students are ready to start learning in each of the scaffolded Common Core standards. With every question the student answers correctly the test adapts and successively asks them a question that has a higher level of difficulty. When students answer questions incorrectly the test then asks them a less difficult question. The process continues until the assessment finds a level that students have comfort with but is still challenging.

MAP is administered as a placement exam for students and is used to track student growth throughout their high school career.

Accuplacer-

The Accuplacer exam is designed by the CollegeBoard to provide quick and accurate data on student proficiency in reading, writing, math, and computer skills.

Accuplacer is often used by colleges and universities to place students out of remedial courses. Many times students are unable to take credit-bearing classes at colleges or universities without placing out of remedial courses first. Students at Bergen Tech. take the Accuplacer Exam at the end of their Junior and Senior years.

Accuplacer is used as a criteria for determining whether students are eligible for Math and Language Arts Literacy Supplemental Coaching.
